IN CREATING THIS WINE LIST, I TRIED TO MAKE IT VERY DIVERSE AND FUN, I CHOSE MANY WINES BY THE GLASS FROM ALL OVER THE GLOBE.

I LOVE THE CLASSICS BUT I AM ALSO VERY PASSIONATE ABOUT FOCUSING ON LESSER-KNOWN DELIGHTS SUCH AS VERDEJO AND ALBARINO FROM SPAIN, OR ARNEIS AND FRIULANO FROM ITALY, OR PERHAPS GRÜNER VELTLINER AND ZWEILGELT FROM AUSTRIA. WHY NOT A DELICIOUS WHITE FROM THE ISLAND OF SANTORINI MADE FROM ASSYRTIKO GRAPE, OR BRANCH OUT AND TRY SOME OF THE GREEK REDS FROM THE XINOMAVRO GRAPE.

MANY OF THESE WINES ARE MORE VERSATILE AND FOOD-FRIENDLY. THEY ARE CRISP, OFFERING EXOTIC FRUIT FLAVORS AND ARE SELDOM HEAVILY OAKED. THOUGH THEY MAY NOT SOUND FAMILIAR TO YOU, I HAVE HOPES THAT THEY MAY BECOME YOUR FAVORITES; THEY ARE SOME OF MINE. WE STILL OF COURSE HAVE THE VANILLA AND CHOCOLATE OF THE WINE WORLD, CHARDONNAY AND CABERNET SAUVIGNON. THE WINE LIST IS CONSTANTLY EVOLVING TO MEET THE NEEDS OF OUR GUESTS. IF WINES ARE MARKED WITH (*), THIS MEANS THAT THEY ARE FAVORITES OF THE MOMENT. ALL WINES ARE SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY. CHEERS!

SPARKLING WINE

CHAMPAGNE

CHAMPAGNE IS A SPARKLING WINE PRODUCED FROM GRAPES GROWN IN THE CHAMPAGNE REGION OF FRANCE. THE PRIMARY GRAPES USED IN THE PRODUCTION OF CHAMPAGNE ARE PINOT NOIR, CHARDONNAY, AND PINOT MEUNIER. TECHNICALLY, IT IS THE ONLY SPARKLING WINE THAT MAY BE REFERRED TO AS "CHAMPAGNE." CHAMPAGNE CAN OFFER ENTICING AROMAS AND FLAVORS OF FRESH BREAD, BRIOCHE, SPICED APPLE, AND SUBTLE CREAMY, YEAST AND NUT-LIKE FLAVORS ARE MORE COMMON IN OLD WORLD CHAMPAGNE.

GROWERS WHO VINIFY THEIR OWN GRAPES ACCOUNT FOR ONLY 5% OF THE ENTIRE CHAMPAGNE MARKET. A FARMER WHO DOES THIS IS CALLED A RECOLTANT-MANIPULANT (GROWER PRODUCER). THESE BOTTLES ARE MARKED WITH THE SMALL INITIALS “RM.” THESE INITIALS SCREAM, I AM THE GROWER! I GREW THE GRAPES IN MY VINEYARD AND I MADE THIS CHAMPAGNE! THESE WINES FOCUS ON TERROIR AND SENSE OF PLACE. THESE SMALL RUN ESTATES OFFER EXCEPTIONAL QUALITY AND VALUE. THESE ARE PEOPLE WHO WORK TIRELESSLY IN BOTH THE VINEYARD AND THE CELLAR, WHOSE DEDICATION TO THEIR CRAFT GOES FAR BEYOND THAT OF MOST PRODUCERS.

NEW WORLD SPARKLING USUALLY, YOU WILL FIND MORE CITRUS AND RIPE TREE FRUIT ON THE PALATE. IF YOU PREFER THE MORE SUBTLE CREAMY, YEAST AND NUT-LIKE FLAVORS ARE MORE TYPICAL IN OLD WORLD CHAMPAGNE.

OLD WORLD – FRANCE, SOUTH AFRICA, ITALY

SAUVIGNON BLANC CAN EVOKE SCENTS OF GOOSEBERRY, GRAPEFRUIT, LIME, AND FRESHLY MOWN GRASS. GROWN IN WARMER PARTS OF THE WORLD, THE MELON, CITRUS AND PASSION FRUIT AROMAS AND FLAVORS EMERGE. THE PUREST EXPRESSION OF THIS MARVELOUS GRAPE (NO BLENDING IS PERMITTED) IS FOUND IN FRANCE, IN THE LOIRE VALLEY (SANCERRE & POUILLY-FUME). IN BORDEAUX (GRAVE'S & ENTRE-DEUX-MERS) ARE GENERALLY BLENDED WITH THE SEMILLON AND SOME MUSCADELLE AND MAY SEE SOME OAK AGING.

NEW WORLD – USA, CHILE, NEW ZEALAND

EXCELLENT SAUVIGNON BLANC IS COMING OUT OF NEW ZEALAND; IT HAS MORE PUNGENT GOOSEBERRY NUANCES, BUT FRAMED WITH FLAVORS OF GUAVA, AND PASSION FRUIT. OTHER GREAT AREAS THAT THE GRAPE PERFORMS TERRIFIC IS IN SOUTH AFRICA, AND CHILE. THIS GRAPE IS INCREDIBLY VERSATILE WITH ALL SORTS OF FOODS AND RARELY DISAPPOINTS!

MEDIUM TO FULL-BODIED, DRY WHITES

CHENIN BLANC (she-nan-blanc)

OLD WORLD – FRANCE, SOUTH AFRICA

SOME OF THE BEST EXAMPLES OF THIS GRAPE COME FROM EITHER SOUTH AFRICA (KNOWN AS STEEN), WHICH TEND TO EMPHASIZE MORE ON THE TROPICAL FRUIT FLAVORS THAN THEIR LOIRE VALLEY, FRANCE. ITS HIGH ACIDITY ALLOWS IT TO BE ABLE TO MAKE EVERYTHING FROM SPARKLING WINES TO DESSERT WINES. VOUVRAY IS A GREAT EXAMPLE OF WHAT THIS GRAPE CAN ACHIEVE. IT MAKES A DIZZYING OF WINE STYLES FROM DRY (SEC), OFF DRY, TO SWEET (MOELLEUX) IN STYLE, DEPENDING ON THE TIME OF HARVEST. IT IS AN EXTREMELY VERSATILE WITH FOOD PAIRINGS. THE LIGHTER, DRYER STYLES CAN PAIR WELL WITH LIGHT DISHES AS SALADS, FISH, AND CHICKEN. THE SWEETER STYLES ARE A TERRIFIC BALANCE TO THE SPICY HEAT OR RICH FOODS SUCH AS TERRINES, FOIE, & GREAT WITH ASIAN AND HISPANIC CUISINES.

FACTS ABOUT MADEIRA

1. IN 1776, MADEIRA WAS USED TO TOAST TO THE SIGNING OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE. OUR FOUNDING FATHERS IN ADDITION TO BEING GREAT VISIONARIES, THEY HAD GREAT TASTE IN WINE. THOMAS JEFFERSON TREASURED THESE IMMENSELY POWERFUL WINES, MADE IN THE MADEIRA ISLANDS.

THE 18th CENTURY AND UP UNTIL THE MID-19th CENTURY WAS CONSIDERED THE GOLDEN AGE FOR MADEIRA AND, NO OTHER BEVERAGE ENJOYED GREATER STATUS AMONG THE AFFLUENT, THAN MADEIRA IN THE AMERICAN COLONIES. IT WAS THE MOST PRESTIGIOUS WINE, SHIPPED TO CONNOISSEURS IN MAJOR SEAPORTS FROM NEW ORLEANS TO BOSTON.
4. MAY 9th, 1768 ONE OF THE MAJOR EVENTS ON THE ROAD TO REVOLUTION IN WHICH MADERA PLAYED A KEY ROLE WAS, THE BRITISH SEIZURE OF JOHN HANCOCK'S *SLOOP THE LIBERTY*. HANCOCK'S BOAT WAS SEIZED AFTER HE HAD UNLOADED A CARGO OF 25 PIPES OF MADEIRA, AND A DISPUTE AROSE OVER IMPORT DUTIES. THE SEIZURE OF THE *LIBERTY* CAUSED RIOTS TO ERUPT AMONG THE PEOPLE OF BOSTON.
5. THE FOUR MAJOR GRAPES VARIETIES USED FOR MADEIRA PRODUCTION ARE (FROM SWEETEST TO DRIEST) MALVALZIA, BUAL, VERDELHO, SERCIAL, AND TERRANTEZ. MADEIRA OFFERS POWERFUL AROMATICS, GREAT LUSHNESS AND VISCOSITY, INCREDIBLE STRUCTURE, AND TANGY CHARACTER THAT ARE ESSENTIAL TO GREAT MADEIRA.
